Eastleigh District Explorer Scouts have been invited to join Gloucestershire County for their Summer Camp next year. Gloucestershire have a well established county camp that started over 20 years ago, GlosCamp is held every four years at Park Farm in Crickhowell, South Wales in the heart of the Brecon Beacons National Park . It is a week's camp for young people in Scouting aged between 10 and 18. Although the camp is targeted and troops and units from the Gloucestershire County we wont be the only outside contingent as next year there is liely to be a group from Denmark.

Activities

In 2006, GlosCamp offered rock climbing, caving, off-road cycling, mountain boarding, kayaking, rifle shooting, pioneering, archery, mountain hiking, and a community project where we worked clearing previously hidden remains of a medieval village. There was also a craft night, team sports, day trip to the big pit and the Roman fort. Scouts could eat with other units as guests and to launch the event there was an opening ceremony and a Sunday Fayre full of activities that each Unit ran plus a food market of local unit specialities. At the fayre there were also juggling, martial arts, fencing and a talk from the National Commissioner for Scouts.

The 2010 GlosCamp will be very similar but planning and booking activities is still ongoing.
