

St George's Day Parade Road Safety

Arrangements are now well in hand for our St George's Day Parade, to be held on Friday 23rd April 2010 at 6:30pm.

It is of the utmost importance that we, as responsible leaders do everything we can to ensure the safety of our young people whilst participating in this important annual parade.

Last year your Parents/Supporters did a magnificent job in policing the road junctions along our route to church and after, back to the Recreation Ground. I am writing to you now to ask that you put this safety plan in place again.

I have allocated each group a road junction below and you should be in position by 6.15pm at the latest.

High Viz coats are important, if you don't have them, please give Ian Patrick a call, he may be able to help.

John Edwards and Phil Hallet will be on the Recreation Ground from 6:00pm to issue each group with appropriate road signs and a radio so that you can track the progress of the parade. Please be sure to collect yours by 6.00pm and return them by 8.00pm

1st & 4th Eastleigh responsible for signs A & C in Leigh at **Leigh Rd.**
(the Parade will enter Leigh Road near the High St)

14th Eastleigh **Hanns Way** in Wells Place opposite Wells Place Centre.

7th & 12th Eastleigh **Desborough Road, Factory Road crossroads, outside the church.** Also responsible for sign A at Factory Rd. Cranbury Rd. junction.

13th Eastleigh **Desborough Road, Blenheim Road crossroads.**
Also responsible for sign C near Swan Centre car park exit.

14th Eastleigh **Hanns Way, Desborough Road junction**

Positioning of all signs must be as shown on the map to comply with our Road Closure Order.

Please remember that we are under public scrutiny to do our job well in this regard,
I trust that each Group therefore will endeavour to see that their particular part of our parade is adequately covered. If you have any concerns about any aspect of these arrangements, please contact myself or DMcG.
