

Gloucestershire Scouts



We plan to take a party of Scouts and Explorers from the County to take part in the 2011 Haarlem Jamborette held near Amsterdam in the Netherlands.

The Jamborette is an opportunity for Scouts and Explorers

- Travel to a foreign country
- Meet Scouts and Guides from all over Europe and beyond
- Take part in the exciting programme of activities arranged at the Jamborette

Dates: Jamborette dates are 31st July to 9th August 2011. The days before and after the official start and end are set aside for Scouts from abroad to arrive and leave the camp. In practice at least another day is added at each end for travel.

This means our provisional dates will be: **Depart: Saturday 30th July Return: Wednesday 10th August**

Cost: The provisional cost is **£465**. This includes –

- Transport from Gloucestershire to the camp
- Insurance
- Activities and trips out organised at the Jamborette
- Jamborette camp fees
- All food
- Practice camp

This cost may vary due to the exchange rate and confirmation of travel fares.

Deposit & cancellations:

- £50 [non returnable] deposit for all Scouts and leaders to be paid by 31st October 2010.
- Further payment of all expenses incurred should a Scout withdraw.
- Numbers might need to be restricted and would be taken on a first come first served basis.

Activities: A very varied and interesting programme is provided which includes –

- A choice of coach trips out to interesting places in the Netherlands
- A choice of day or over-night hikes
- Various sporting activities on and off site using local centres

- The chance to meet Scouts and Guides from many different countries and cultures
